



Tractor Pull Rules – Friday Night

Farm Stock tractors: 3500, 4500, 5500, 7000, 9000 12000, 15000

Powder Puff tractors: 4000 and 5000

Open tractors: 4000, 5500, 7000 and 9500

Hot Farm tractors 9500 and 11000

Open Mod tractors: 6000

Rules for Farm Stock and Powder Puff classes

Tractors must be naturally aspirated or be equipped with factory installed turbos or blowers (Oliver 99GM, Allis Chalmers D19, 190XT etc.)

Gas, diesel or LP fuels only. No alcohol or nitrous oxide fuels may be used in tractors. Must have original type block. Power Blocks OK. Diesels must have stock diesel fuel injection equipment.

No custom built manifolds. Must have stock style manifold and carburetor.

Rules for Hot Farm classes

Hot Farm tractors limited to 20.8 tires, 3" turbo "P" Pump, no cut tires

Rules for Open class

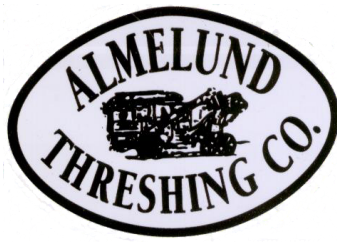
Tractors must have chassis and sheet metal from a farm tractor. One engine only.

Wheelie bars, rear kill switch, clutch scatter blanket or 1-4" thick steel covering the flywheel is required in the Open Class.

Any gear, any speed.

No steel wheels. Two wheel drive only. No duals.

Cut tires on Hot Farm and Open tractors only.



Tractor Pull Rules – Saturday Afternoon

The following weight classes will apply for **Tractors 1960 or older**: 3000, 4000, 5000, 6000, 7000 ,9000 and 12000.

The following weight classes will apply for **Tractors 1957 or older**: 3500, 4500 and 5500.

All tractors **lighter than 6000 lbs.** will have a **speed limit of 4 mph**. Tractors **6000 lbs and above** will have a **speed limit of 6 mph**. Any RPM is allowed.

No turbos, or horsepower increasing injection equipment will be allowed. Tractors must have stock carburetion or stock LP equipment. Diesel tractors must have stock diesel fuel injection equipment. Tractors must have stock appearing block, cylinder head and manifold of agricultural origin. Blocks must bolt directly to OEM chassis and frame. No Power Blocks.

No steel wheels. Two wheel drive only. No duals. No cut allowed on tires.



Tractor Pull Rules – Sunday Afternoon

1. Tractors 1975 or older.
2. The following weight classes will apply (**for tractors without steel wheels**): 3000, 4000, 5000, 6000, 7000, 9000, and 13000.

For tractors with steel wheels: 4000, 7500

3. No modifications whatsoever, no removal of original equipment, all tractors **MUST BE STOCK**. Stock RPM. Must have working governor, stock exhaust etc.
4. Drawbars must be factory, factory extensions only. Puller must provide pulling clevis. Drawbars must be stationary in all directions. Sled must hook to factory drawbar.
5. Factory weights only attached with OEM bolts in the OEM location. No non-factory weight brackets or weights.
6. Two wheel drive only. No duals
7. Any tractor that pulled Classic or Antique cannot pull Vintage.
8. All tractors must pass tech inspection prior to weigh in. All rules will be interpreted by the Rules Committee.

Any unforeseen problems or oversights will be ruled on by the Rules Committee with their rulings being final.

9. Diesel fuel injection pumps must be set to stock specs. Tech personnel will rule on this and will disqualify tractors with excessive smoke.
10. If the flagman believes a tractor is over RPM, the tractor will be immediately sent to the quarantine area for testing.

The driver must stay seated on the tractor until testing is complete.
